To become a certified planner, members of the American Planning Association (APA) must meet certain education and experience requirements and pass the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) Exam. The pass rate is the percentage of test takers who pass the examination within 3 years of graduating from a master's program, and/or within 5 years of graduating from a bachelor's program.

## EMPLOYMENT RATE

The Employment Rate measures the percentage of MURP graduates who obtain planning positions or elect to pursue an advanced degree within one year of graduation.

75% of 2013-2014 graduates were employed in a full-time planning or planning-related position within one year of graduation. Planning or planning-related jobs include: project engineering for local public works departments, coordinator at Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), Environmental Health and Safety Planner for MD Anderson Cancer Center.
